



On the 12th February 2005 I was privileged to witness the birth of my beautiful Tracker (affectionately called Trackie Dack). He has been my constant companion and dear friend for almost 7 years.

Tracker had the most incredible temperament and was loved by all who met him. He was an Australian Champion and also was awarded 15 Excellent Medallions in the German Shepherd specialty ring under national and international judges. My warmest thanks to Carolyn Booker for helping with his training and showing him in the breed ring. In August 2011 Tracker gained his Endurance Title (ET) - a distance of 20kms - a wonderful achievement.

Tracker sired a number of litters and produced some beautiful progeny with a number of them in the Obedience ring.



Tracker collapsed and died on Saturday 21st January at the Vineyard Veterinary Hospital. It was unexpected and devestating as he had not been ill. My thanks to Dr Rob Zammit for his wonderful care of my beautiful boy.
