Obedience Champion Euraidd One Night Stand CCD UDX NRA - "Yogi"



Louise Patterson and I have owned and bred Golden Retrievers, in partnership, for over 30 years. We have shown and trialled our dogs together in that time.

Nine years ago I moved to Queensland and took 3 of our Goldens with me. I eventually lost 2 of them and in 2006 it was time for another puppy. I told Louise I wanted a boy who worked like Jarrah (Ch Euraidd Just A Gigolo UD), so 2 girls were mated to Jarrah. The litters were born in January 2007, 2 weeks apart. Over the 2 litters I had 11 boys to choose from

I flew down to Sydney at the end of February 2007 to look at the pups. It was a very hot day with the temperature in the 40s. All the pups wanted to do was lay under the verandah in the shade. There was no way I could determine character or willingness to please under those conditions. So we did as we usually did and went over them for conformation. The choice came down to two and my final choice was made on head shape and pigment.

We talked and talked about registered names and decided that as Jarrah was a "Gigolo" his son could be a "One Night Stand".

I couldn't decide on a call name. However when puppy arrived by plane and bounced out of his crate, my husband said he looked like a baby bear and that his name should be either Humphry or Yogi. Well I didn't like Humphry, so he became "Yogi"

"Yogi" was so quick to learn. He amazed me. He would do anything for a tennis ball and that became our prime motivation, plus lots of love.

He gained his CCD at 11months, his CD at 14 months, his CDX at 20 months and his UD at 2years and 10 months.

He then went on to gain his Obedience Championship at the age of 4 years and 3 weeks. In June 2011 "Yogi" became the first Gundog in Queensland to gain his Novice Retrieving Ability Title (NRA) I decided that we would then tackle UDX, thinking it would take some time to get this title. To my delight "Yogi" learned his UDX exercises and gained his title within 12 months.

And he is still only 5½ yrs old. Along the way he was also awarded Top Obedience Dog by the Golden Retriever Club of Queensland for 2009, 2010 and 2011.

And also Top Obedience Dog by our All Breeds Training Club of Redlands for 2011.

Our next goal is to gain his Obedience GRAND Championship.





Ever wondered just how many hamburgers or chocolate your dog eats every day? The Hills pet food people tell us that feeding your dog one small plain biscuit or 1 slice of buttered toast is equal to feeding them 1 hamburger or a 50g chocolate bar.

And a small amount of cheese adds up to 1½ hamburgers or 75g of chocolate. So keep the treats for training- they work!



Spring **clean**

Fleas suck blood, make puppies anaemic and your dog itchy and they spread tapeworm.

There are many tablets and spot-on treatments - but a good old fashioned bath - with some **Permoxin** (a popular rinse that can be used weekly) will make a big difference. Permoxin also controls ticks when used weekly.

After the bath - controlling fleas

With severe flea infestations, controlling the flea eggs and larvae that are in the house and garden is the priority.

A single flea lays hundreds of eggs. The eggs drop from the animal's coat and are thereby spread around the environment the animal lives in. They hatch into larvae which progress through a pupal stage to adult fleas.

The first step to controlling fleas is to do a thorough spring clean. Remove as much dirt and debris from your pet's environment as possible. Vacuum the house, paying attention to areas near the skirting boards and under furniture as this is where the eggs are known to accumulate. Concentrate on any area in which your pet sleeps. Dispose of the dirt from the vacuum cleaner into a rubbish bag, add some insecticide spray or flea powder and then place it in the garbage bin.If you are having a major problem with fleas, try 'bombing' the house with flea bombs available from your supermarket.

ALSO: THE CLUB AWARDS A TROPHY* FOR ANY TITLE GAINED DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR FOR BREED AND OBEDIENCE. THESE AWARDS ARE GIVEN AT OUR CHRISTMAS PARTY.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>* In order to be eligible for a Club Trophy for Breed and Obedience titles, you must attend training classes at least 50% of the year or attempt to assist the Club in other ways, ie stewarding. Those who don't meet these requirements will only be awarded a trophy at the discretion of the Committee.
