Jacko was a big personality dog and lots of fun. He is greatly missed by Bill and his happy face will be very missed on the grounds at Blacktown.

Teaching your dog some new tricks

High five

Teaching your dog to high five is incredibly easy and is a great trick to amuse young children.

Start by commanding your dog to sit, and reward him with a treat. Next, hold a treat in front of him but slightly out of reach.

Repeat the command "high five" whilst gently tapping one of his feet. Most dogs will raise their foot to paw at the treat in your other hand.

As he raises his foot, catch it with your free hand. As soon as you make contact, give your dog the treat and lots of praise.

Keep repeating these steps until your dog raises his foot automatically every time you give the command. If your dog needs a little encouragement to lift his foot off the ground, gently tap the inside of his knee with your finger until he bends his leg.

As soon as his paw is off the ground, gently tickle the bottom of his foot to encourage him to raise it higher. Continue to say the command slowly and firmly as you repeat the steps.

Some dogs will eventually be able to perform this trick without you having to give the command. Simply commanding your dog to sit and then raising your hand in front of him will be enough to get him to give you a high five.



Tasty raw treats

- Carrot sticks
- **Apples slices** Remove the seeds and core first.
- **Pineapple chunks** Make sure to peel off every bit of that spiny skin.
- **Blueberries** Freeze 'em for a chilly summertime treat.
- **Cucumbers** Cucumbers are mostly water, making them super hydrating and appropriate for pets that might be on calorie-restricted diets

If you have any doubt as to whether or not something is ok for your dog to eat consult your veterinarian, and always avoid onions (or anything in the onion family), grapes, mushrooms, avocado, and tomatoes.

Have you thought of trying Herding





Herding is fun and a great social activity. It gets you outdoors, keeps you active and is good exercise for all involved. Herding will intensify the relationship between you and your dog. It's a great pleasure to watch dogs perform the basic farm work they once were used for.

All breeds of herding origin are welcome (including dogs that are registered on the Associate Register and are clearly a mix of herding breeds.)

If you would like to see what is involved ANKC Herding trials are held one weekend a month at Dogs NSW Complex at Erskine Park from March to October.

Saturday herding training at Orchard Hills, beginners training is on 2nd & 4th Saturday at 9am and is conducted by NSW Herding Association. You are required to be a member of this club to train on Saturdays and can join on the day. \$5 Training fee per dog. **Sunday herding training** at Orchard Hills is held on Sundays by Australian Stock Dog Club from 9am until midday for beginners. You are required to be a member of this club to train on Sundays and can join on the day. \$5 Training fee.

To compete for ANKC Herding Titles you will need to be a member of Dogs NSW and your dog will need to be registered on the ANKC Register a dog does not need to be a purebred, it may be registered on the Associate Register.

All results MUST be received by 31st October. Entry forms are on the opposite page.

To qualify, all passes must be obtained between 1st November of the preceding year up to 31st October of the current year.

ALSO: THE CLUB AWARDS A TROPHY* FOR ANY TITLE GAINED DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR FOR BREED AND OBEDIENCE. THESE AWARDS ARE GIVEN AT OUR CHRISTMAS PARTY.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>* In order to be eligible for a Club Trophy for Breed and Obedience titles, you must attend training classes at least 50% of the year or attempt to assist the Club in other ways, ie stewarding. Those who don't meet these requirements will only be awarded a trophy at the discretion of the Committee.
